For 400 acres Wheat Harvesting & Threshing

The PLDDB has been aimed to develop Livestock & Dairy sector of the Punjab while facilitating the small & large farmers in production, processing & marketing with the latest infrastructure and modern farming technologies to improve their animals' genetics and milk/meat production ratio.

PLDDB intends to hire the services of a technically sound organization/individual for the 400 acres wheat harvesting and threshing at Livestock Experiments Station, Khizerabad district Sargodha. Following are the Terms and Conditions:

- Interested party must have the sufficient machines and man power for the harvesting of wheat and to manage the harvested wheat and wheat straw within time.
- Wheat will be harvested through roots for wheat straw production.
- Interested parties have to submit 2% earnest money in the name of PLDDB (refundable) along with the Bid.
- No quotation will be accepted after due date & time.
- Bidding Document may be taken before or on 15th April, 2015 from PLDDB head office by paying Rs. 500.
- Bids should be submitted in a single sealed envelope containing two envelopes of Technical & Financial bids separately (financial bid should be quoted on "Per Acre" basis).
- PLDDB may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to acceptance of a bid or proposal as per PPRA Rules.

Interested parties may submit their bids on Bidding Documents before or on 20th April, 2015 at 3:00 pm, at the address given below.
